

# REGULATIONS

(See also *Special Division Rules*)

## General Rules

- Competitions are open worldwide unless otherwise stated.
- The Norfolk County Agricultural Society reserves the right to:
  - Refuse admission to any person or group.
  - Deny exhibition privileges without explanation.
  - Direct placement of animals, vehicles, and exhibits on the grounds.
  - Require removal of any animal, vehicle, or exhibit that does not comply.
- Judges' decisions are final; no appeals will be accepted.
- The Society is not responsible for loss, injury, damage, or theft of exhibits.
  - Exhibitors assume all risk.
  - Directors will assist in recovery but **no compensation will be paid**.

## Entries

- All entries must be made through the Fair Office, **172 South Drive, Simcoe**, or online at [www.norfolkcountyfair.com](http://www.norfolkcountyfair.com).
- Entry deadline: **5:00 PM, Saturday, September 26, 2026** (unless otherwise noted for a division).
- Late entries (day of show) will be accepted with a **\$25.00 late fee** in addition to the **15% fair share deduction**.
- Horses not entered before the start of a competition will **not** be recognized on the field.
- All entries must include:
  - **Exhibitor's Fee:** \$10.00 per exhibitor.
  - **Proof of \$2,000,000 liability insurance.**
- Prize deductions:
  - A **15% Fair Share** will be deducted from all prize winnings.
  - Where a premium per entry in a class is shown, no additional premium will be paid beyond prize money.
- **All fees must be paid at the time of entry** or entries will not be accepted.

## Premiums & Prize Money

- If rain or inclement weather causes the Fair to operate at a financial loss (after government rain insurance is applied), prize money may be reduced proportionately.
- Prize winnings will be mailed from the Fair Office by **October 31, 2026**.

## Exhibitor Conduct

- Abusive or disrespectful language toward judges or officers will result in:
  - Forfeiture of prize money.
  - Suspension from exhibiting for one year.
  - Mandatory reporting of violations by judges or officers.
- Grounds conduct rules:
  - No reckless driving or riding (penalty: immediate removal).
  - No sitting in aisles or blocking entrances.
  - No entering the show ring unless an official.

## Horses

- All horses must:
  - Be free of disease.
  - Have a valid Health or Vaccination Certificate (if applicable).

- Be subject to veterinary inspection if required.
- Medication rules:
  - No horse may compete if administered a forbidden substance (stimulants, depressants, tranquilizers, anesthetics, or masking drugs).
  - Breed Association regulations apply.
  - Animals are subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian.
  - Refusal to cooperate with a veterinary exam will be reported to the governing body.
- Other requirements:
  - Horses may not be tied to a truck or trailer overnight.
  - Colts must be shown in halter and tied while on the grounds.
  - Teams, pairs, and single horses must be shown to a **four-wheel vehicle** unless otherwise stated.
  - Manageable stallions may compete in any class **except** lady drivers and juniors (Equine Canada Rule Book, Ch. IV, Part I, Sec. 18).
- The Fair reserves the right to:
  - Split large classes.
  - Cancel, postpone, or combine classes (decision by Horse Committee Chair or Vice Chair only).
- Donated prizes not competed for become property of the Society.

## Stalls & Bedding

- Initial straw bedding is provided.
- Additional straw: **\$8.00 per bale** (request on stall sheet or during online registration).
- Standing stall fee: **\$10.00 per horse per day**.
- Draft horse exhibitors are welcome to layover to show at Rockton.
- Stall requests must be made online during registration or on the stall sheet (stall numbers not guaranteed, dependent on show size).
- Stall fees must be paid prior online or at the Horse Show trailer **before moving horses into stalls**.
- Stall hours and straw availability are listed on the stall sheet.

## Exhibitor Attire & Equipment

- Proper attire is required, suitable to the class entered.
- Safety hats must be worn properly fastened when required.
  - All types of headgear must remain worn throughout competition.
  - Points may be deducted if headgear is lost.

## Gate Admission

- Exhibitors must treat gate admission as part of their entry fee.
- Free admission applies to: Driver & Those showing the horse.
- All other persons must have a **pass** or pay regular admission.

ALL SINGLE HITCHES CAN BE HOOKED TO WAGON OR CART, ALL REMAINING CLASSES HOOKED TO 4-WHEEL VEHICLE.

- When multi-horse hitches are composed of horses other than those owned by the named entrant, the split of prize money is the responsibility of the entrant. No split of prize money will be made by the Society.
- Exhibitors using junior drivers under 18 years of age must have an adult on the wagon.
- All Six Horse Hitches must have two adults on the wagon during competition.
- No entry is complete unless the animal is named on the entry form and registration number must also be shown.
- 15% Fair Share will be deducted.
