

Rules & Regulations

- All competitions listed in the prize lists are open to competitors of the world, except where otherwise stated.
- The Exhibitor's Fee is \$10.00 per year.
- A 15% fair share will be taken off all General livestock & Poultry winnings.
- All fees must be paid before submitting your entries. Unpaid items will be disqualified.
- **Entries must be submitted online or brought to the Fair office, No later than Saturday September 26, 2026 by 5:00 pm to avoid late entries. All late entries will be subject to an extra \$5.00 late fee.**
- In the event of doubt, a committee consisting of the Chair and two committee members, or any two of them, may require a statutory declaration confirming compliance.
- If any deception or dishonest practice is discovered, the committee may withhold prizes, ban the exhibitor and any collaborators for one or more years, and may publish their names.

PRIZE MONEY

- Cash Prize Pick-Up: Earnings under \$20 will be paid in cash only at the Fair Office. Available from Wednesday, October 14, 2026, to Friday, October 30, 2026. Pick up at the Fair Office - 172 South Drive, Simcoe BLDG # 5.
- Unclaimed cash prizes after November 3, 2026, will be forfeited and considered as a donation to the NCAS.

CHEQUE PRIZE PICK UP

- Available from Wednesday, October 14, to Friday, October 30, 2026, at the Fair Office 172 South Drive, Simcoe BLDG # 5.
- After Nov, 3, 2026, remaining cheques will be mailed out (subject to postal service availability).

PLACING OF EXHIBITS

- Livestock and Poultry must arrive by stipulated times for Veterinarian health inspection before placement. Cattle must be show-ready per the judging program.
- All livestock for competition must strictly follow the prize list. No prize will be awarded to any entry without a number.
- Entries will be accepted **only** for livestock appearing in the printed Prize Lists.
- All Cattle and Llamas must be secured by the head; Goats and Sheep confined in pens. Owners must follow safety and display instructions from the Committee.
- Certificates of pedigree for purebred animals must accompany the animal and be available upon request.
- Names, numbers, and birth dates of all registered stock must be recorded on the entry form.

JUDGING

- Exhibitors must bring livestock forward when called or be disqualified.
- Judges shall award premiums based on merit, regardless of competition presence, unless specified otherwise.
- Judges may be required to give reasons. No interference with judges is allowed; violators will forfeit prizes and be excluded.
- Anyone who uses disrespectful or abusive language toward a judge or official will lose all prizes and be banned from competing for one year. Judges and Officers must report violations immediately.
- Judges' decisions are final regarding prize awards.
- Protests for rule violations may be made by exhibitors or interested parties. A \$25.00 deposit is required. If the protest is not upheld, the deposit is retained. Decisions by the designated committee are final.
- No price tags shall be shown on any competition entry during the Fair.

GENERAL

- Exhibits cannot be removed until the designated time in each department.
- Reckless riding or driving on the grounds is prohibited and will result in immediate removal. Sitting in aisles, blocking entrances, or entering the show ring is forbidden except by officials.
- The Directors will take precautions for safety, but all exhibitions are at the owner's risk. The Society is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft.
- The Society reserves the right to restrict access to its grounds and to deny exhibition privileges without explanation. Exhibitors must follow instructions on the placement or removal of animals, vehicles, and exhibits.
- All Livestock and Poultry must be disease-free, accompanied by applicable Health or Vaccination Certificates, or be subject to veterinary inspection.

Rules & Regulations:

Cost of Showing

- Exhibitor's fee is \$10.00
- A 15% fair share deduction will be taken from all prize winnings.
- All entry fees **must** be paid prior to showing.

Gate Admission & Parking

- Livestock Driver, and Exhibitors are free.
- All others must pay regular admission.
- All cattle trucks must be moved to the parking lot immediately after unloading.

Entries

All entries can be made online norfolkcountyfair.com **CLICK COMPETITIONS**

To avoid late fees entries must be entered no later than Saturday, September 26, 2026.

- **All** late entries for the Cattle Show will be accepted **after this date** for a **\$5.00 late fee per class on top of your exhibitor fee**, in addition to the regular 15% prize deduction.
- Postmarks must show sufficient time for entries to arrive by the deadline.

Each entry must include:

- Registered name
- Registration number
- Date of birth
- Tattoo
- Class number (for catalogue preparation)

Entry Limits

- Livestock Division: Max 2 animals per exhibitor per class. Excluding 1 entry in the Breeder's Herd Class.
All entries must remain on the grounds until officially released. Early removal may result in forfeiture of prize money.

Definition Of An Entry

- For Dairy and Beef classifications:
All purebred registered cattle (owned individually or jointly), maintained on the same farm or breeding unit, are considered one unit.
Multiple operations with shared interests are considered a single breeding unit.

Premier Breeder & Exhibitor Class Tie

- In the event of a tie, the winner will be the one with the Premier Breeder & Exhibitor Class Tie most first-place and/or second-place finishes.

General

It is the responsibility of the owner and/or exhibitor of any livestock (dairy or beef cattle, sheep) to ensure that every animal under their care have the required approved tag as per CFIA regulations before entering our Fairgrounds.

- Inferior or mediocre animals will be refused entry.
- A Culling Committee (Co-Chair and two committee members) may disqualify any unfit entries.
- Registered cattle housed together are considered from one **breeding unit**, even if ownership varies.
- Projected milk production from a computer-printed inspection report is acceptable if:
 - The report was printed within 60 days of judging, and
 - Based on a minimum 90-day lactation period.
 - May be used for cow or daughter qualification – not sons.
 - Photocopies or sales catalogue pages will not be accepted.
- All tattoos will be verified.

Health Regulations:

All animals must comply with:

- Norfolk County Fair regulations, Agriculture Canada standards, as well as may be subject to veterinary inspection.

Release Time:

Cattle will not be released until 5:00 PM on the day of the show.

Entry Requirements

- All entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor.
- No person may make an entry as both an individual and as a farm or limited company.
- All registered animals, whether owned by one person or jointly by more than one person, which are maintained on one farm or breeding unit, are considered to be the production of one farm or breeding unit. Therefore, only one entry per class is eligible from such a unit, except as authorized in rule above.

- Any person who shares any portion of joint ownership in any animal entered shall be precluded from showing another animal in their own name or farm name in the same class.
- All general rules of the Norfolk County Fair will apply.
- In the event that fewer than three exhibitors and/or eighteen animals show in a division, only one-half of the prize money shown will be paid, or the breed may be combined with another division at the discretion of the competition chairperson.
- Exhibitors are requested to open the sheep's mouth if the judge wishes to examine the sheep's teeth.
- Entries in Get of Sire must NOT have 3rd incisors.

Entries close September 26, 2026.

Late entries for the sheep show may be submitted for a late fee of \$5.00 per entry, in addition to 15% fair share.
